### Planning

Our theme this term is **Occupations** and the children will enjoy fun learning around this theme covering all the areas of learning and development in the EYFS. Throughout each week, the children will take part in **Talk Time, Friends Game, Jolly Phonics, Praise Tots with Lyn Kelly (Tuesdays), French Lessons on Wednesdays, Dance sessions every other Thursday, Soft Play at the sports centre (Fridays), Nursery Rules, PE and stories.**

**Week 1 28<sup>th</sup> November**, we will be looking the bakers shop, also making Christmas Cracker decorations, and playing on the Bully field.

**Week 2 5<sup>th</sup> December**, we will be looking at the Greengrocers shop, and maybe go for a walk and buy some vegetables. The children will be chopping up vegetables in the role play area. We will be making Christmas cards, and cone glitter decorations. There may well also be a nature trail around the Bully field. We will be visiting South Cave School and watching their school play on Monday.

**Week 3 12<sup>th</sup> December**, we will be looking at what the police and doctors do and our role play corner will be a hospital. We will be making police hats, calendars and snowflakes. The older children will be learning the green cross code in the car park.

**Week 4 19<sup>th</sup> December, this is a non-school week.** We will be joined by some of our Bears School Group children and will be making paper chains, and snowflakes. The occupation is Father Christmas!

**Week 5 3<sup>rd</sup> January**, we will be looking at the work of a teacher and the role play area will be set up as a school. There will

be junk modelling on the go, together with boats in the water.

**Week 6, 9<sup>th</sup> January**, we will be discussing firemen and rescuers and matching uniforms to pictures. We will discuss the important role this people do. We hope to bake some biscuits this week.

**Week 7, 16<sup>th</sup> January**, we will be looking at Farmers and the work they do. Our role play area will be a home corner. There will be water and measuring jugs out together with soil and tractors in the tough spot.

**Week 8, 23<sup>rd</sup> January**, This is the final week of this terms planning and we will be concentrating on Shopkeepers. It's a week where the children choose what toys they would like out of the cupboard, so there could be all sorts out in the room.
